Nuremberg is the center of an European Metropolitan Region with 3.5 million inhabitants and 1,800,000 jobs.

- Important region in Bavaria for **higher education and research**. There are 18 universities and universities of applied sciences with over 120,000 students (winter semester 05/06) within a radius of 100 km of Nuremberg.

- Top position among the **European technology regions**, especially in microelectronics, communication and information technology, energy and environment, automation and production engineering, new materials, transport and logistics, medical technology and optical data transmission
- Main branches of industry: mechanical engineering, electrical engineering/electronics, printing, radio broadcasting/telecommunications, medical technology, control & instrumentation, writing utensils
- One of the **leading innovation regions**; holds 3rd place Germany-wide for the number of patent registrations per inhabitant
- **High quality of life** (according to a study by W. M. Mercer: 23th place among 218 cities worldwide)
- **Environmental conditions** - In a comparison of environmental conditions in 218 important cities throughout the world, Nuremberg shares 17th place with Bern, Copenhagen and Boston.
- One of the **most attractive city centers** in Germany with aboveaverage level of central shopping and art-historical attractions

Location and transport connections

- **Airport:** International airport with direct connections to all major European economic centers and almost 4 million passengers a year; subway line to main railway station, city center and exhibition center
- **Motorways:** Junction of the European highway network and gateway to the neighbouring East European states
- **Rail:** Intersection of ICE and international long-distance lines
- **Port** on the Main-Danube Canal, the only waterway route between Western and Southern Europe
- Center of the third largest integrated local transport system in Germany
