

## Daycare for Children in Nuremberg

## What is daycare for children?

Daycare is not babysitting! It is a form of supervision for mainly small children provided by a male or female child minder, where the children are regularly looked after for at least a few hours a day.

The child minder plays, sings or crafts with your child at their home or in other locations. The children eat there together. The child minder also takes your child outside to the playground or for walks.

Our child minders in Nuremberg have been approved by the youth welfare office (Jugendamt). They have the permission to take care of a maximum of five children from other families at the same time.

It is important that you stay with your child during the first days that they get to know the child minder. Your child stays alone at the daycare location as soon as they feel comfortable.



# How can you find a daycare place?

One placement office inform and give advice to parents and child minders on behalf of the youth welfare office (Jugendamt) of the city of Nuremberg. The child minders have completed a pedagogical qualification and support the development of your child.

### How much does the daycare cost?

Information about the cost of supervision by child minders can be found at the placement offices.

Depending on the income of the family, the youth welfare office (Jugendamt) subsidises the costs, or covers the entire costs upon application.
