

Nuremberg Statistics (as at 31.12.2015, unless otherwise stated)

Nuremberg is Bavaria's second-largest metropolis and by inhabitants (528,514 on 31.07.2016) is ranked 14th among German cities. Over 21 per cent of its citizens have a foreign nationality; over 43 per cent are immigrants. Most people live in a one-person household (50.7 per cent). 289,721 people are in employment subject to social security payments, 18,493 are registered as unemployed, a quota of 6.4 per cent (on 30.09.2016). The gross domestic product per gainfully employed person is 66.553 Euros. Nuremberg is among the world's 20 largest trade fair locations. Trade fair visitors and tourists coming to the city make over 3 million overnight stays per year. In 2016, there were 70,293 residential buildings with an average living space of 39.4 square metres; the average rent (without heating) for flats without public funding was 7.31 Euros per square metre. Nuremberg Albrecht Dürer Airport has 3.38 million passengers annually, as well as over 60,000 take-offs and landings.
