Lots of things cost less with the Nürnberg-Pass, for example:

- Learning a foreign language
- Going to the zoo
- Joining a sports club
- Attending a lunch for senior citizens
- Going to a museum
- Travelling by bus and train

The Deutschland-Ticket Nürnberg-Pass



- Costs 19 euros.
- Is valid for 1 person (with a valid Nürnberg-Pass) and is non-transferable.
- Is valid throughout Germany on local public transport (ÖPNV) and regional transport (S-Bahn and R-Bahn).
- Is available as an annual subscription, the fees are debited monthly from your account.
- Can be cancelled every month.
- Is available as a paperless ticket or chip card here: https://meinabo.vag.de
- Entitles you to use VAG bikes every month (600 minutes free of charge).

Who is entitled to the Nürnberg-Pass?

The Nürnberg-Pass is available to children, adults and senior citizens from Nuremberg.

You must live in Nuremberg and receive welfare payments. Your welfare payments may be from the following offices:

- The Job Centre (unemployment benefit II, ...)
- The Social Welfare Office (basic income support, assistance with living costs, housing benefit, benefits for asylum seekers)
- The Family Benefits Office (child supplement)
- The Youth Welfare Office (subsidy for kindergarten fees, ...)
- The District of Middle Franconia (basic income support, assistance with living costs, cash allowance)

How do I apply for the Nürnberg-Pass?

Please let us know in writing who you are, where you live and that you would like to apply for the Nürnberg-Pass. You will need a copy of your identity card or passport and the notice from one of the offices referred to above.

Write to us using the online contact form on the Nuremberg Social Welfare Office website (<u>www.nuernberg-pass.</u> <u>nuernberg.de</u>) and upload the copies as PDF files here.
