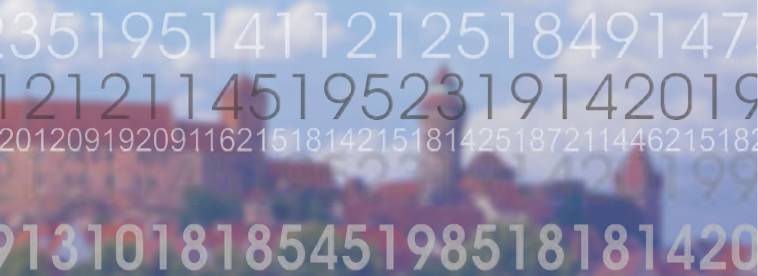

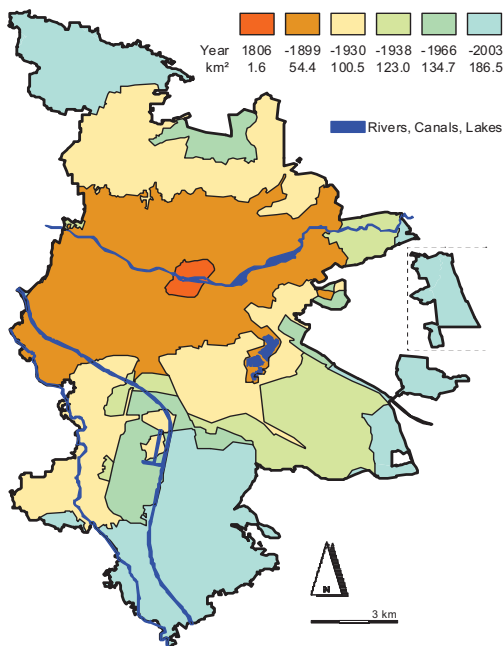

Development of City Area since 1806

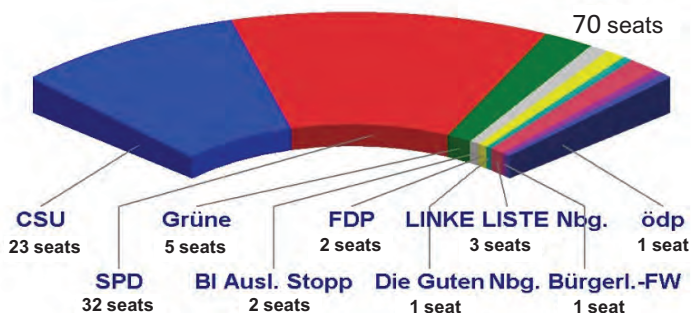

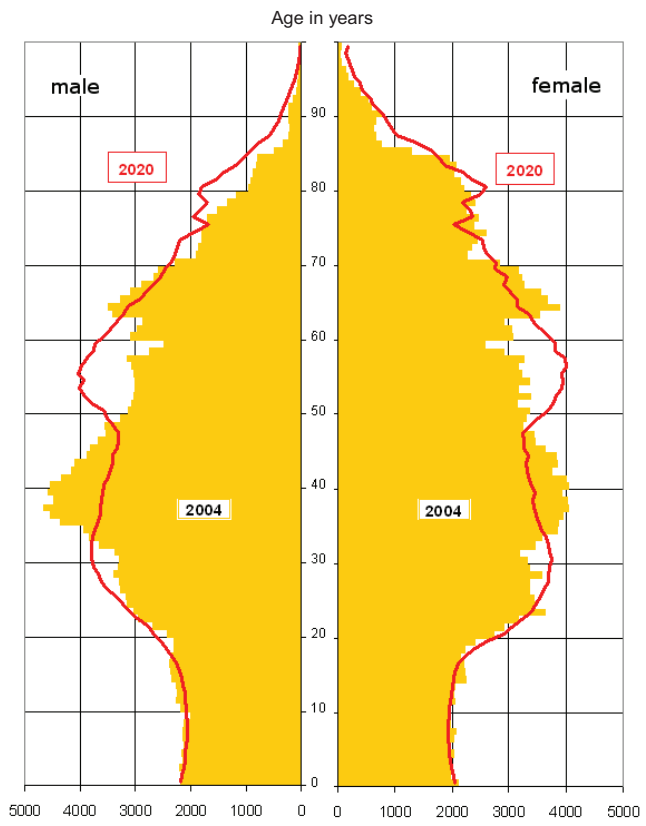

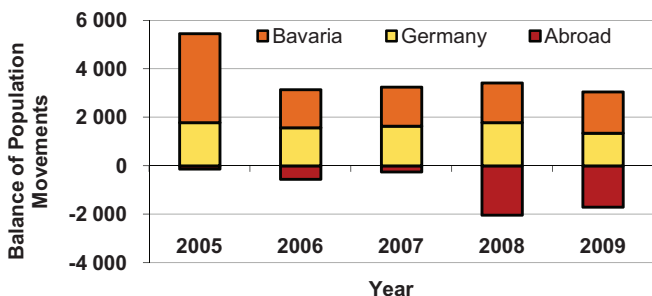

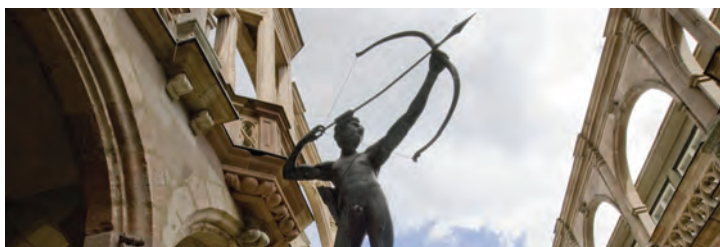
Net Gains and Losses with respect to Bavaria, Germany and Abroad 2005 - 2009

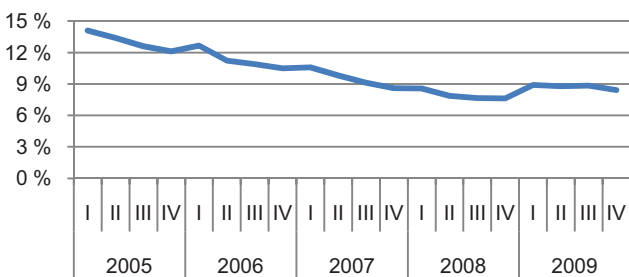

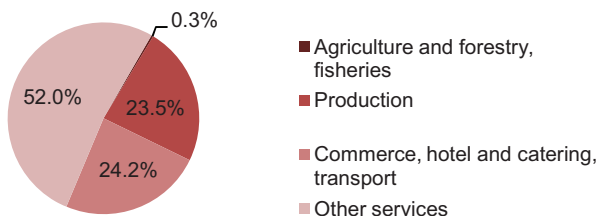
Development of Unemployment Rate¹⁾

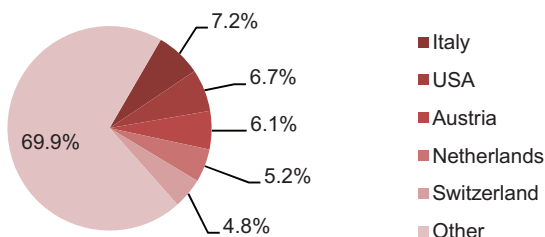

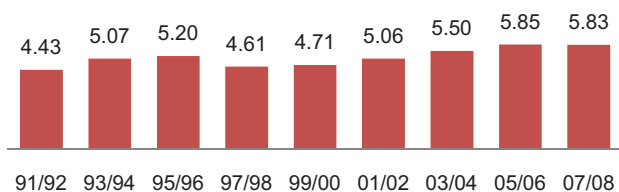

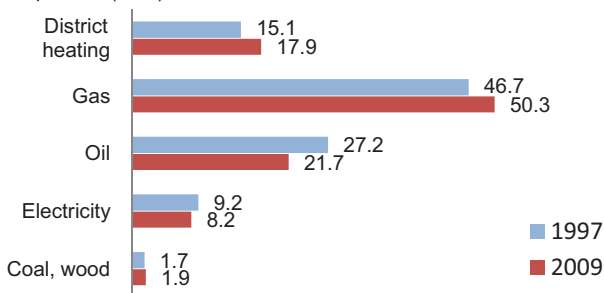
Average net rent exclusive of heating (in Euro per m²)
