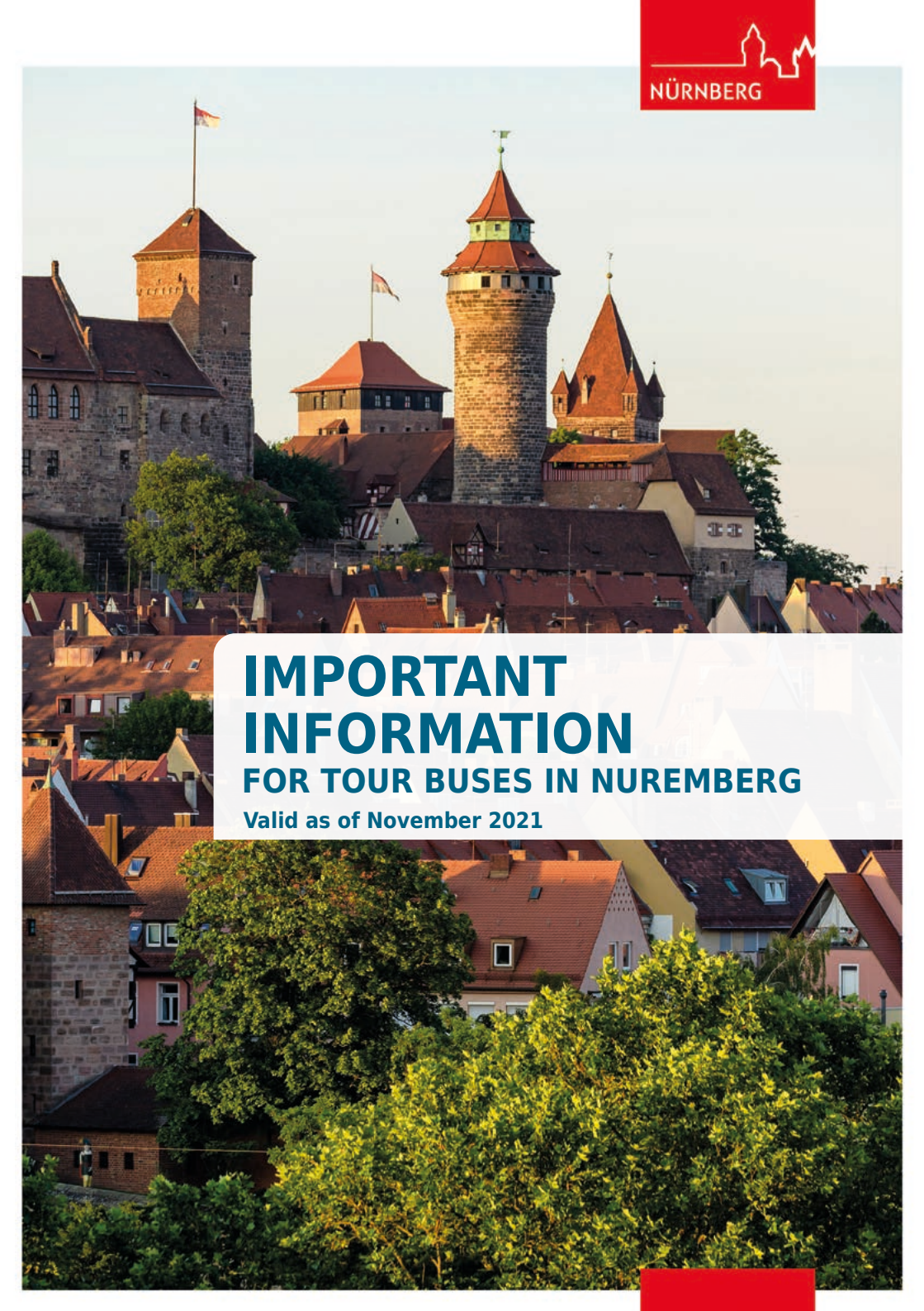

BUS STOPS AND PARKING FOR TOUR BUSES IN NUREMBERG

On the next pages you will find an overview of the bus stops and parking spaces for tour buses in the city of Nuremberg.

Please note that the Nuremberg Old Town has a medieval character with many narrow streets. Hence there is no possibility within the Old Town to allow a large number of tour buses to drop off and pick up passengers.

On the edge of the Old Town there are a number of bus stops and short-term parking spaces available at Vestnertorgraben, Grasersgasse and Spittlertorgraben, from which your passengers can reach all the important sights in the Nuremberg Old Town within 15 minutes.



USE OF AUGUSTINERSTRASSE FOR PERSONS WITH LIMITED MOBILITY

Entry to the Augustinerstraße via Hallertor and the use of the bus stop lane there is, in general, not permitted.

For buses with mobility-impaired persons, access is possible in individual cases by means of a fee-based access permit (issued in accordance with §46 StVO). The permit can only be booked online at: **[busslots.nuernberg.de](https://www.busslots.nuernberg.de)**.

There you will find a user handbook with detailed explanations of all functions and an FAQ section. To receive a permit, you must pay a fee which is based on current regulations. If you cancel your reservation, your fee cannot be refunded due to German law.

Each permit is valid only once and only for the requested time slot. This permit must be shown to the security staff at the Augustinerstraße. A separate permit is required for drop off or pick up of guests.

If you enter the Augustinerstraße without a valid permit or exceed your time slot, it is considered a misdemeanor offence. The city of Nuremberg reserves the right to prosecute this offence.

In the case of a repeat offence, the city of Nuremberg will review whether to issue future permits to an offender.



PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS WHILE DRIVING IN THE OLD TOWN

- ⚠ Tours which do not have the Old Town as their primary focus (tours to the Documentation Center Nazi Party Rally Grounds, for example) should use the bus stops in Grasersgasse or at Vestnertorgraben, if a short visit to the Old Town is desired.
- ⚠ Shuttle service to and from the cruise ship harbor may only use the pick-up and drop-off point in Grasersgasse.
- ⚠ If several buses are used, mobility-impaired persons should be concentrated in one bus, so that special access can be reduced to a minimum.
- ⚠ A bus may only arrive in the Augustinerstraße at the specified time and leave at the end of the slot. Waiting for late guests is not permitted.
- ⚠ If you will not use your reservation, we ask you to cancel as a courtesy to other drivers, so they may use your time slot.



TIP FOR AVOIDING WAITING TIME:

- ➡ Depending on the traffic situation, the exact travel time from where your bus is parked to the Augustinerstraße is not always predictable. We recommend that you use the bus parking spaces at Vestnertorgraben as a short-term waiting area. From there you can be in the Augustinerstraße within approximately 5 minutes, regardless of the traffic situation.

We ask you to rebook your reservation as soon as it is clear that you will not use your assigned time slot.

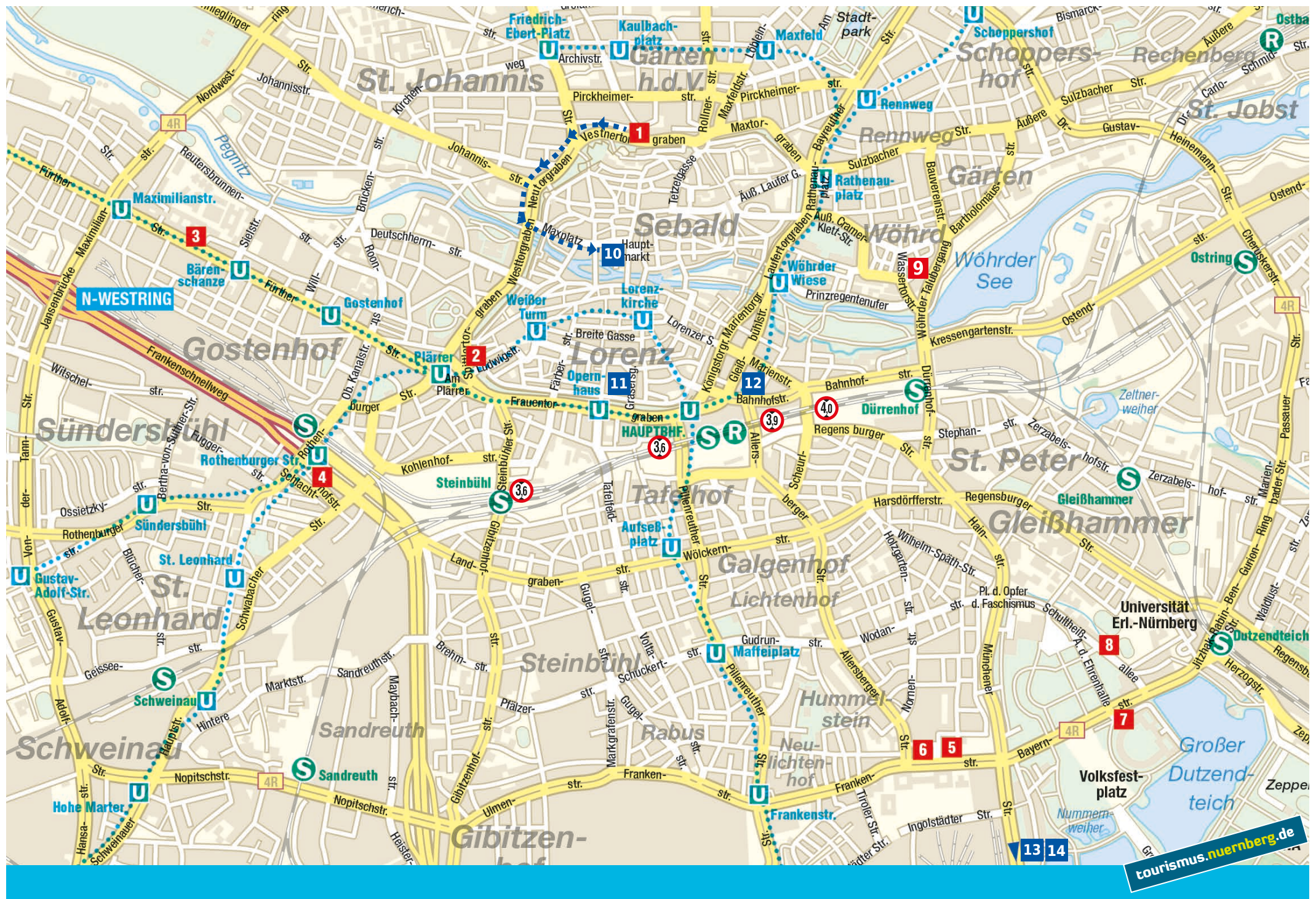
LOCATION	NUMBER OF SPACES	TIME LIMIT
1 Vestnertorgraben: South side in the bus parking bays; north side opposite the restaurant "Zum Hexenhäusle" Toilet: Automatic public pay toilet	15 parking spaces	2 hours
2 Spittlertorgraben: Northeast side, between Ludwigstor and Fürther Tor	4 parking spaces	2 hours
3 Fürther Straße/at the Nuremberg Courthouse	2 parking spaces	9 am – 6 pm
4 Rothenburger Str. [U] / Frankenschnellweg, Toilets: Free	2 parking spaces	unlimited
5 Frankenstraße: North side, at the eastern start of the right turn lane to Hiroshimaplatz	4 parking spaces	unlimited
6 Frankenstraße: North side, west of Hiroshimaplatz to 10 m east of the pizza stand	6 parking spaces	unlimited
7 Bayernstraße (by-pass north of the Congress Hall): North side, only for visits to the Documentation Center	4 parking spaces	3 hours
8 Schultheißallee: East side, north of Seminarweg	6 parking spaces	unlimited
9 Wöhrder Talübergang: East side, north of Wassertorstraße. Space may be limited due to construction	6 parking spaces	unlimited



PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF POINTS: PARKING PROHIBITED

LOCATION	NUMBER OF SPACES	TIME LIMIT
10 Augustinerstraße: South side, vehicle access for pick up and drop off from 9 am to 6 pm only with a special permit for mobility-limited persons	4 bus stops	Max. 10 minutes
11 Grasersgasse: West side, at building Nr. 10	8 bus stops	Max. 15 minutes
12 Käte-Strobel-Straße: Central Bus Station	1 bus stop	Only for pick up of city guides. Max. 15 minutes
13 Breslauer Straße: North of the Franken Center, between the two branches of Otto-Bärnreuther-Straße	4 bus stops	Max. 15 minutes
14 Liegnitzer Straße: At the P+R Langwasser Süd	2 bus stops	Max. 15 minutes

HEIGHT LIMITATIONS

Please be aware of the height limitations of the railway underpasses:

-  **Celtis Underpass: 3.60 m**
-  **Marientunnel: 4.00 m**
-  **Allersberger Underpass: 3.90 m**
-  **Steinbühler Tunnel: 3.60 m**
